




We cling to God's truth



Keep on Pressing On





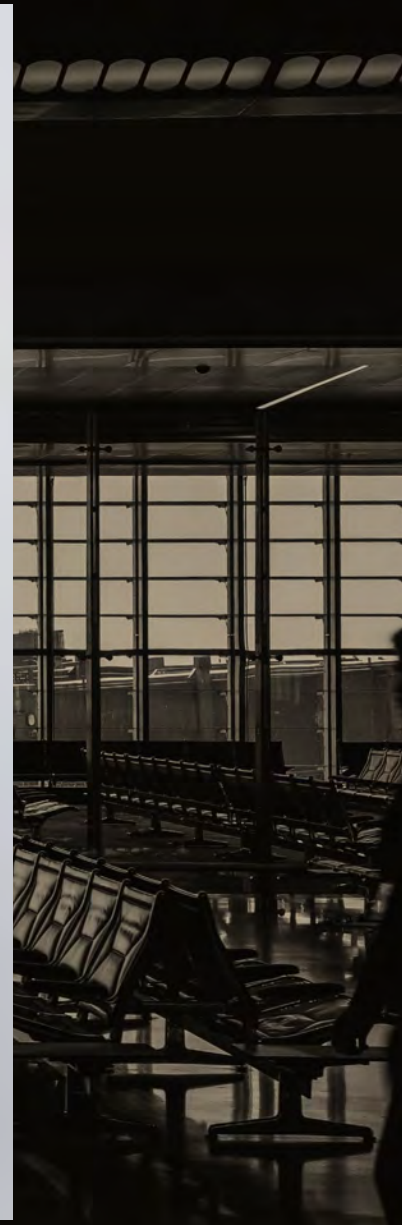
