we now act upon the process and reap death



Perseverance is the stamina (grit) to endure the process of Christ-likeness

Growing up, we were told by guidance counsellors, career advice books, the news media and others to "follow our passion." This advice assumes that we all have a pre-existing passion waiting to be discovered. If we have the courage to discover this calling and to match it to our livelihood, the thinking goes, we'll end up happy. If we lack this courage, we'll end up bored and unfulfilled — or, worse, in law school.

But this philosophy puts a lot of pressure on the rest of us — and demands long deliberation. If we're not careful, it tells us, we may end up missing our true calling. And even after we make a choice, we're still not free from its effects. Every time our work becomes hard, we are pushed toward an existential crisis, centred on what for many is an obnoxiously unanswerable question: "Is this what I'm really meant to be doing?" This constant doubt generates anxiety and chronic job-hopping.

Three Part Passion Never

Faith without these two elements is dry and unfruitful. The two things Jesus spoke against constantly

Absence of these elements speaks to the state of spiritual decay

Three Part Passion be lacking in zeal

earnestness, diligence (faithful)

"Who then is the faithful and wise servant, whom the master has put in charge of the servants in his household to give them their food at the proper time? It will be good for that servant whose master finds him doing so when he returns." Matthew 24:45-46

diligence is activity of the Kingdom

Three Part Passion

Epaphras, who is one of you and a servant of Christ Jesus, sends greetings. He is always wrestling in prayer for you, that you may stand firm in all the will of God, mature and fully assured. I vouch for him that he is working hard for you and for those at Laodicea and Hierapolis.

diligence can be defined as the movement of being faithful

Three Part Passion but keep your spiritual fervour

Greek – zelos , zeo (to boil, be hot)

excitement for God

They asked each other, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he talked with us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us?"

Luke 24:32

Three Part Passion

for our "God is a consuming fire." Hebrews 12:29

Do not quench the Spirit. 1 Thessalonians 5:19

For this reason I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands. For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline. 1 Timothy 1:6-7

The fervour is spiritual, not emotional
